DOG LICENSE APPLICATION – Kalkaska County, Michigan

Michigan Law requires that all dogs 4 months of age and older to be licensed

To apply for a dog license:

- 1. Fill out the application below.
- 2. Include a copy of the current rabies certificate from a veterinarian.

After February 28th – License fee is doubled.

- 3. Include a copy of the spay/neuter certificate, if applicable, and not noted on the rabies certificate
- 4. Include payment.

<u>If applying by mail</u>, any paperwork included with your application will be returned to you with your dog license. Send all of the above documents along with a check or money order made **payable and addressed to Kalkaska County Treasurer**, **605 N Birch St, Kalkaska MI 49646**

<u>If applying in person</u>, bring all of the above paperwork to the Kalkaska County Treasurer's office at 605 N Birch St, Kalkaska MI during business hours of Monday – Friday, 9:00 am – 5:00 pm. When applying in person, you may pay with cash, check, money order or for a convenience fee you may pay by credit card.
